## ≻ For Homeschool Co-ops, Cottage Schools, University-Model Schools, and Private Tutors

Each enrolled family should purchase a copy of the curriculum directly from stonesouppress.com before the beginning of classes.

## ≻ For Private Schools and Online Classrooms

The school must provide each teacher with a separate PDF copy of the curriculum, purchased directly from stonesouppress.com

In addition, an <u>annual seat fee of \$25 per student</u> is payable to Stone Soup Press before the beginning of classes. Payment of the fee gives the school permission to provide the student with print copies of any student worksheets, vocabulary lists, or other reproducible materials from the curriculum for the duration of the school year.

A separate seat fee is required for each curriculum a given student uses during that academic year. For example, for a student enrolled in one Latin course using *I Speak Latin* and one literature course using *Exploring the World through Story*, the seat fees would total \$50.

Schools may wish to defray this cost by asking families to pay a materials fee.
